Directions:

5 km north of Dublin city, 20 mins by car to Dublin Airport Turn left onto Malahide Road from Fairview Strand. Continue thru Griffith Ave junction up Malahide Road pass Nazareth House Nursing Home. Take next turn left into Casino Park at stone archway. Our Entrance Gates are on the left.

WELCOME TO CASINO MARINO



Casino is one of Europe's finest neoclassical temples dedicated to the Arts. It was designed in 1759 as a Pleasure House for James Caulfeild, 1st Earl of Charlemont by Sir William Chambers, one of the finest architects of the time. Charlemont and Chambers created a unique and intriguing Garden Temple from which to overlook the magnificent panorama of Dublin Bay.

The Casino, meaning 'small house' surprises visitors as they discover the remarkable secrets of this architectural gem. The lavishly decorated and compact exterior cleverly disguises an interior of intimate rooms displaying intricately ornate Georgian motifs. Richly patterned marquetry floors and beautifully executed plasterwork act as an historical backdrop to the Casino's past which is lovingly brought to life by our friendly and knowledgeable tour guides.

Cared for by the OPW (Office of Public Works) the Casino at Marino is regarded internationally for its exquisite craftsmanship.
